1.	Meeting was not quorate and postponed
2.	<p><b>Recruitment</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Members agreed that recruitment of new resident members is required</li> <li>b. It was confirmed that there are 3 vacant places: 1 general membership and 2 places for younger adults</li> <li>c. Members need to decide on a recruitment approach</li> <li>d. Members agreed for the Clerk to contact the previous successful applicant to see if they were available to join the Community Board</li> </ul>
3.	<p><b>Regeneration programme update</b> — there was a question received in advance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Households that have decided to stay on the estate are secure tenants</li> <li>b. TA don't have an offer to stay but are part of the rehousing programme</li> <li>c. 45 moves have been agreed, 31 are secure tenants and 14 are temporary</li> <li>d. Current rehousing of phase 1 and those that are choosing to move off the estate is to avoid moving twice and a few for personal reasons</li> <li>e. Expected that this will change over time for residents in phase 2–5 where moving twice does not apply</li> <li>f. There are 40 to be confirmed and this is due to practical reasons and manage the rehousing programme (need to stagger rehousing notices)</li> <li>g. Movement of Ely Court residents couldn't start until they became RBK tenants in October</li> </ul> <p><b>Questions/discussions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>h.
