Since 2015 Kingston Council has been looking at how they could improve homes on the Cambridge Road Estate by building new ones including more social rented homes - this is called regeneration.

As well as new homes, the Council would like to improve all outdoor spaces and create a new community centre. The Council also want to provide training for local people, new jobs, and local business opportunities.

The council has now chosen the housing developer Countryside to help work with residents to prepare designs for the regeneration.

In Autumn this year, Cambridge Road Estate residents will vote to decide whether the regeneration should happen or not. This newsletter tells you all the important dates you need to know about, and all the different ways you can get involved.

RESIDENT BALLOT AUTUMN 2019

If you think that the regeneration is a good thing for you and your family it's important for you to vote yes. Nothing will go ahead unless residents vote 'yes' this Autumn 2019 in the 'Cambridge Road Estate Regeneration Ballot'.

The ballot will be run independently of the Council and we'll be getting in touch soon to let you know how to take part.

Before the ballot takes place this Autumn, the Council and Countryside are working to design new homes and outdoor spaces with residents.

Below are some of the activities that you can take part in to have your say about the regeneration plans.

IDEAS | MAY AND JUNE 2019



1st Public Exhibition | For the first exhibition, the architects prepared sketches of the new estate for residents to see. These are on display at the Tadlow Hub for resident feedback.



Idea Sessions | The architects will be making models and more drawings to show residents at the idea sessions. This is so residents can help design the new homes, outdoor spaces, and community facilities.



Trips | Residents are invited to visit similar places built by the same developer, to see what Cambridge Road could look like. A coach will take you and drop you back home.



Drop in anytime | Housing Landlord services will be at hand at all events and at the Tadlow Hub to help residents understand their housing offer and options.

DESIGNS | JULY 2019



2nd Public Exhibition | The second exhibition will be the first time the architects will show how all the ideas received from residents have come together. Drawings, models, and pictures will be shown so that residents can tell us what they think.



Design Sessions | The architects will work with residents to discuss details of their new homes and how all the outdoor spaces fit together.



Drop in anytime | Housing Landlord Services will be at hand at all events and at the Tadlow Hub to help residents understand their housing offer and options.

FINAL PLANS | SEPTEMBER 2019



Public Exhibition | The design team will finalise the masterplan based on feedback, and the final version of the masterplan will be presented to residents. Based on this and the Landlord Offer, all eligible residents will make their ballot decision.



Landlord Offer | A document called the Landlord Offer will be shared with everyone who can vote in the ballot. It will include the final designs and plans for the estate, the estimated number of new homes and what kind of homes they will be. There will also be details of the offer for social rent council tenants, leaseholders and freeholders.


